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The editorial board of **GYANYOG** □ □ □ □ □ □ □ □ are pleased to announce the commencement of the publication of GYANYOG □ □ □ □ □ □ □ □ – a peer-reviewed scientific journal being published by the Universal College of Science and Technology (UESC). We are glad to issue this **Call for Papers** to all scientists, researchers, practitioners, and students of engineering of any disciplines of physical and social sciences to submit their research papers and research articles for publication in the maiden issue of the journal, scheduled for publication soon.

The following paragraphs provide the manuscript guidelines (abridged) for Authors. A separate document called “Gyanyog Template\_for\_Manuscript” (attached) has been prepared that is compliant to the style requirements of Gyanyog. This template can be used to write one’s paper ensuring compliance to Gyanyog requirements for paper for publication.

**Guidelines for Author for preparing manuscript.**

- Manuscript should be original, and not submitted or published elsewhere. Selection for publication will be based on their scientific contribution, innovation, and pertinence to the targeted engineering problems.
- Manuscript should generally include sections such as introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, and conclusions. However, authors may structure differently based on the manuscript’s focus. The introduction should be a review of earlier studies, establishing context and necessity, followed by the study, followed by clear research questions.
- Length of the manuscript is expected within 8,000 words in MS Word format, using A4 size page with 25 mm margins, Times New Roman font at 12-point size, single-spaced and with continuous line numbering.
- All manuscripts should be in the English language. However, if the author wishes to publish in another language, an English abstract is mandatory. A manuscript template is attached; authors are encouraged to use it by overwriting onto it their own text. The template also contains samples for Figures, Tables, equations and so on.
- Title should be concise, within 20 words and three lines, accurately representing the manuscript’s content.
- Author details, including name, affiliation, and email address, should appear right below the title. The corresponding author should be indicated with an asterisk (\*) with detailed contact information.
- Abstract: The abstract should be brief, with a maximum of 250 words, covering the study’s context, objectives, methodology, key findings, conclusions, and implications. References should not be included in the abstract unless necessary.

- Keywords: Provide 4-6 keywords in alphabetical order after the abstract.
- Sections/sub-sections: Organize manuscripts into appropriate sections and sub-sections, numbered as 1, 1.1, and 1.1.1 with a maximum of three levels. Abstracts, keywords, acknowledgments, and references should not be numbered.
- Table and Figure: Table and figure should have a resolution of at least 300 dpi, be placed appropriately within the manuscript, and labelled with clear captions, numbered sequentially as 1. 2.
- Equations – All equations should be sequentially numbered and created using MS Word’s built-in “Equation Editor”.
- References and citations: follow APA style for references and citations, as detailed available in the Mendeley reference manager (<https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines/references/examples>)
- Submission: Manuscripts should be submitted electronically including both Word and PDF versions to: **gyanyog@uesc.edu.np** until the online submission system is operational.
- The Final Decision for the publication process will be made by the **Editor-in- Chief**.
